
MY ANTHOLOGY

And her feet bestooled by the Moon


When shall I be delivered

That her family may rejoice





To reach the end


From start the message they carried


HOW TO SUCCEED

And desire spiritual gifts


These attitudes

To convict of sin


Who is he that darkens counsel?

With me, humbly be


Blessed, art thou O man!

The garment of praise for the spirit of heaviness


